

2010 South Australian Road Race Championships

There has been a strong sentiment with the road racing community over the past couple of years that the state championship should be conducted over more than one round. We have also seen the promoters who have taken on the responsibility of the championship faced with declining numbers of competitors. The end result is that in 2010 there are no clubs willing to conduct the state championship.

This, in conjunction with the loss of the Australian Championship round suggests that it is time for a good hard look at the state championships, to be followed by a restructure. Rather than restructure in haste, in 2010 we will “rest” the prevailing structure and for one year, the championship will be conducted as described below, with the objective of a new format being confirmed by October 2010.

Classes for 2010 SA Road Race Championship

Limited A, B, C & D Grade (e.g. Café Racer Club Limited; Formula Mac Park + 2 valve 750cc)

600cc (675cc Triple, 750cc Twin) A, B, C & D Grade (racing within class or within Unlimited)

Unlimited Twin A, B, C & D Grade (other than in Limited)

Unlimited A, B, C & D Grade

Sidecar A & B Grade

Race Meetings for 2010 SA Road Race Championship

Note: None of these race meetings will carry “SA Championship” status.

21st March, Café Racer Club, Mallala

2nd & 3rd April, Easter Cup, Mac Park

13th June, Café Racer Club, Mallala

5th September, Café Racer Club, Mac Park

1st & 2nd & 3rd October, Master of Mac, Mac Park

21st November, Phoenix, Mallala (incorporates SA Junior Championships)

The Café Racer Club meeting of December 12th is deliberately excluded to enable point scores to be completed in time for MSA Presentation Night on December 4th

Point scoring methodology for 2010 SA Road Race Championship

Points will be accumulated for outright placing in races as per GCR 12.14.0.1. The sum of a rider's 3 highest point scores will be their tally for the race meeting.

Points scored in Bracket Racing are explicitly excluded from state championship totals.

Promoting Clubs tasks for 2010 SA Road Race season

- 1) Provide a programme and a complete list of all finishers and places, outright within races at the above race meetings, to the Road Race Manager as soon as possible after the completion of the event to enable points to be updated.
- 2) Provide input to the restructure of the SA Road Race Championship for 2011
