

Adelaide Equity Cafe Racer Club Championship

Cafe Racer Club of SA president, Rob Graham today announced that Adelaide Equity would join the club as sponsor of the annual Cafe Racer Club Championship, South Australia's showcase of it's world famous road racing talent.

Scheduled for Mallala Motorsport Park on December 14th, the Adelaide Equity Cafe Racer Club Championship puts over \$5,000 in prize money up for grabs attracting South Australia's top riders, interstate and international competitors. The first Cafe Racer Club Championship event was won in 2006 by this year's British Supersport Champion Glen Richards. The 2007 Club Champion and British Superbike racer, Dave Johnson is back in 2008 to defend his title.

The voice of the World Superbike Championship telecasts, and recent round winner of the World Endurance Championship, Steve Martin, returns home to South Australia to present the awards for the Race Bike Services Steve Martin Cup at the final of the four round series, which will be held at the event. Steve will also conduct two-up rides around the track for lucky prize winners.

Rounding out the day will be the final of the Sonnex Laser Reece Bancell Trophy. Last year's Sonnex Laser Reece Bancell Trophy final was fought out to the last race of the year by Michael Blunden and Adam Christie, runner up in the 2008 National Superstock Cup. This year the series leaders Graham Snaith and Steve Leach go into the final separated by just one point, to battle for the hottest C&D grade championship in the state.

Supporting the series is the Bridgeland Motorcycles Unlimited Solo featuring the cream of South Australia's road racing talent, plus the Auldana Foundations Limited Solo, the "have a go" class. Historic racing will feature classic machinery and riders. SA's legendary street-class continues with novice racers competing in Bracket Racing. A competition practice day and Knee Scrapers Ride Day for recreation riders will be held on Saturday 13th December, providing the opportunity for street riders to experience the challenging Mallala circuit.
